General Summary:

The Creative Specialist – Webcast and Podcast Production is responsible for the technical production of webcasts and podcasts for the firm. They facilitate all technical aspects of live and recorded/on-demand webcasts and podcasts, including the in-office conference room/recording location setup, operation of AV equipment, and other related aspects of production. They coordinate with the firm's Webcast Manager and local technology teams to support the presenters and participants to ensure a smooth and professional performance. They also edit recordings using various software programs, including the Adobe Creative Suite of products.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

"Essential duties" are those that an individual must be able to perform with or without reasonable accommodation.

- 1. Coordinates all aspects of the production from pre-production to post-production, including recording and editing programs
- 2. Directs participants for the desired response and performance, including setting up production hardware such as webcams and microphones, and providing best practices on hardware usage and composition, lighting, and audio considerations
- 3. Provides technical support to presenters and participants before and during the recordings and livestreams
- 4. Provides timely and proactive support to participants; troubleshoots technical issues; quickly diagnoses and resolves technical issues that may arise before or during recordings and livestreams
- 5. Assists with the maintenance and testing of remote recording equipment and software, including coordinating repairs and replacements
- 6. Researches and evaluates hardware and software in the market applicable to recordings, makes recommendations to the firm regarding new products
- 7. Maintains working knowledge of latest industry techniques and trends
- 8. Promotes effective work practices, works as a team member, and shows respect for coworkers
