Securing a dismissal of claims against Apple regarding cryptocurrency technology implementation

The resolution of a decade-long price-fixing litigation for StarKist also exemplifies her strategic approach to complex antitrust matters. Through careful navigation of economic and class certification issues she secured partial summary judgment that substantially limited plaintiffs' claims before reaching a favorable settlement. In re.
